

#### **The Firebird** by Susanna Kearsley

Susanna's love of the unexplained permeates all her books, including this one. In *The Firebird*, we are also reunited with familiar faces from previous books: Rob, from *The Shadowy Horses* returns as friend to the main modern day character, Nicola. And we flip back in time to be reunited with Anna, a small child in *The Winter Sea*. I always appreciate Susanna's attention to detail in the historical segments of her books. In this one we visit Russia in the age of Peter The Great and his Empress Catherine. Fans of historical fiction will enjoy this one.

#### One Night On The Island by Josie Silver

Yes, this month it's another Josie Silver and another 5 stars from me. It would be so easy to read the synopsis and think it's just another iteration of the 'forced proximity' trope. Cleo, a writer, arrives on Salvation, a remote Irish island, in the hope of finding herself. Mac, a photographer, is seeking refuge from the disintegration of his family in the home of his ancestors. But in the confines of Otter Lodge, surrounded by the hauntingly

beautiful island and wrapped in the warmth of its inhabitants, each finds more than they ever hoped for. This is a special book, and I've just bought it in print format to go alongside my audiobook.

#### **Again Rachel** by Marian Keyes

Another one of my must-read authors, since I first picked up *Last Chance Saloon* so many years ago. This is a sequel to one of my favourite Marian Keyes books, *Rachel's Holiday*. You don't need to have read it to enjoy this one, but I would still suggest you do. Also, I recommend this in audiobook, read by the author herself in her gorgeous lilting Irish accent. Have your tissues ready. I laughed, and I ugly-cried on this emotional rollercoaster. A few parts left me totally wrecked, but the ending soothed my troubled heart. It is the most beautiful account of how Rachel (and Luke) overcome the very worst of what life can throw at you.


