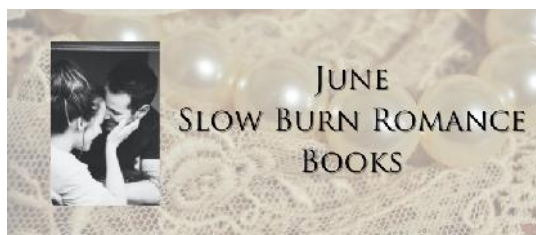
Second Chance Love
