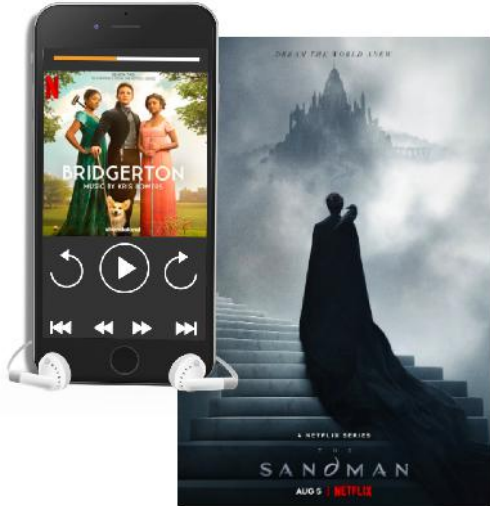


The pick of my August reads..

I had a slow start to my August reading, as Covid forced me to choose between reading and writing—and writing had to take top priority. But I've really enjoyed these two books. **The Diamond Eye** is a classic example of don't judge a book by its cover. I chose it on the strength of the author, Kate Quinn, and I wasn't disappointed. The fictionalised story of a real

Russian woman who becomes an army sniper in WWII, it closely follows her memoir. The photos of Mila at the end were a poignant touch. A great

story of how even through the tragedy of war, the human spirit and love can triumph. **Maybe In Another Life** is my new favourite Taylor Jenkins Reid book. Much as I loved both her highly successful books, *The Seven Husbands of Evelyn Hugo* and *Daisy Jones & The Six*, this is the one that does it for me. Hannah Martin returns to Los Angeles after a trail of unsatisfying attempts at finding her best life. Finally back in the same city as her best friend Gabby, and her first love Ethan, one pivotal decision sees Hannah's story branch out in two different directions. I'm a tad obsessed with the concept of the multiverse and parallel lives (as my own books show). This book delivered an interesting take on the concept, and not one, but two HEAs.



My new favourite writing music–

is the **Bridgerton Soundtrack!** I love the string adaptations of modern songs that formed the backdrop for both series. They are perfect for getting me in the writing mood. My favourite track has to be *Wrecking Ball*–just beautiful. Post-Covid I've been watching a bit more tv, and what a great time for the new series **The Sandman**. One episode and I was

hooked by the moody character of Morpheus and the atmospheric settings. Hubby was not so enchanted, so it will be my guilty pleasure to watch when I probably should be doing other things.

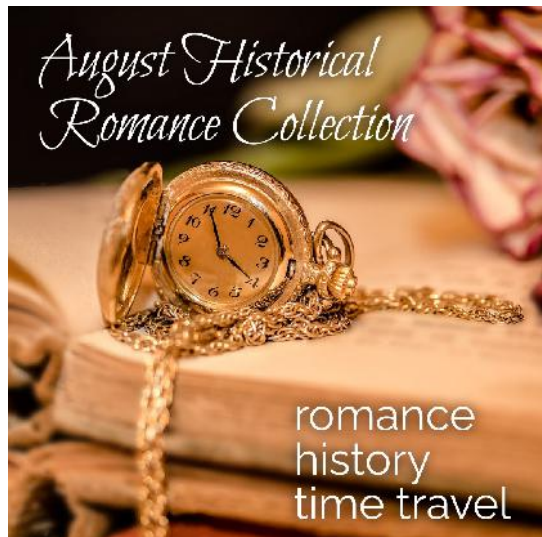
