September has been an emotional rollercoaster with these two books!

I loved **Every Summer After** by Carley Fortune. It's a classic summer read: a friends to lovers, coming of age romance. Told in two timelines, in the past one it is a lovely slow burn, showing the blooming relationship between Sam and Percy across the summers of their teens. The present timeline sees them have

the opportunity to revisit the events that tore them apart, and try to forgive. A really sweet story, but the spice is there too.

Daisy Jones and The Six by Taylor Jenkins Reid, the story of a 70s rock band told in interview format, was a reread for me. I liked the book, but in audiobook format it blew me away. The cast of narrators are outstanding and for me created an intense emotional connection with the characters. In audio this will easily be one of my top reads of the year. I can't wait to see the tv series starring Sam Claflin (*The Hunger Games, Me Before You*) as tortured lead singer Billy Dunn and Riley Keough (Elvis's grandaughter!) as the inimitable Daisy Jones. I've been listening to **Midnight Oil**, an iconic Australian band that my husband and I saw as teens (we'd been together three weeks!) at a music festival many, many years ago. We were lucky enough to be in the front row at their concert last week, as they wind up their final ever tour. I just love seeing artists who are just as good and relevant now as they were in the past. Farewell guys, you will always be special to us.

My house, my castle



Spring has arrived in New Zealand.


