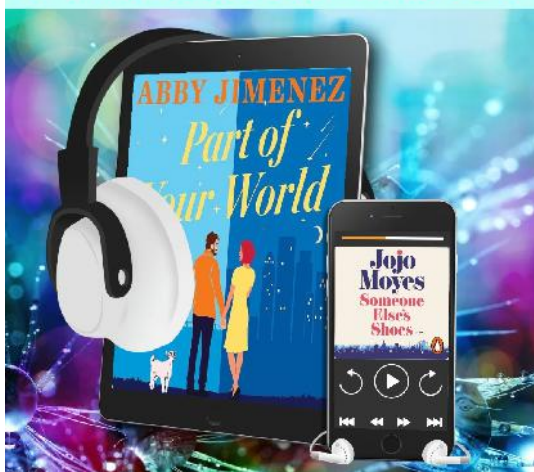

Author Update

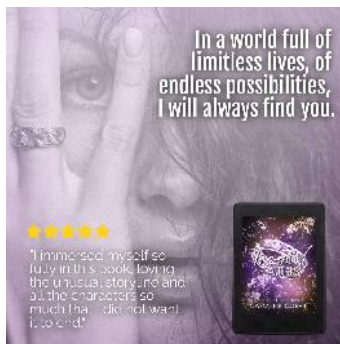
Caroline's writing life

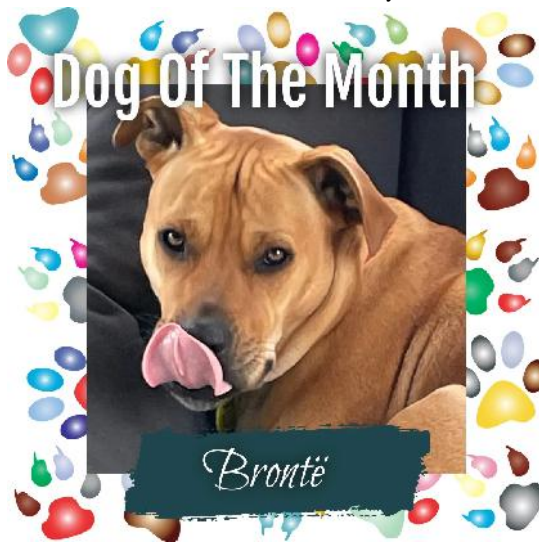
