

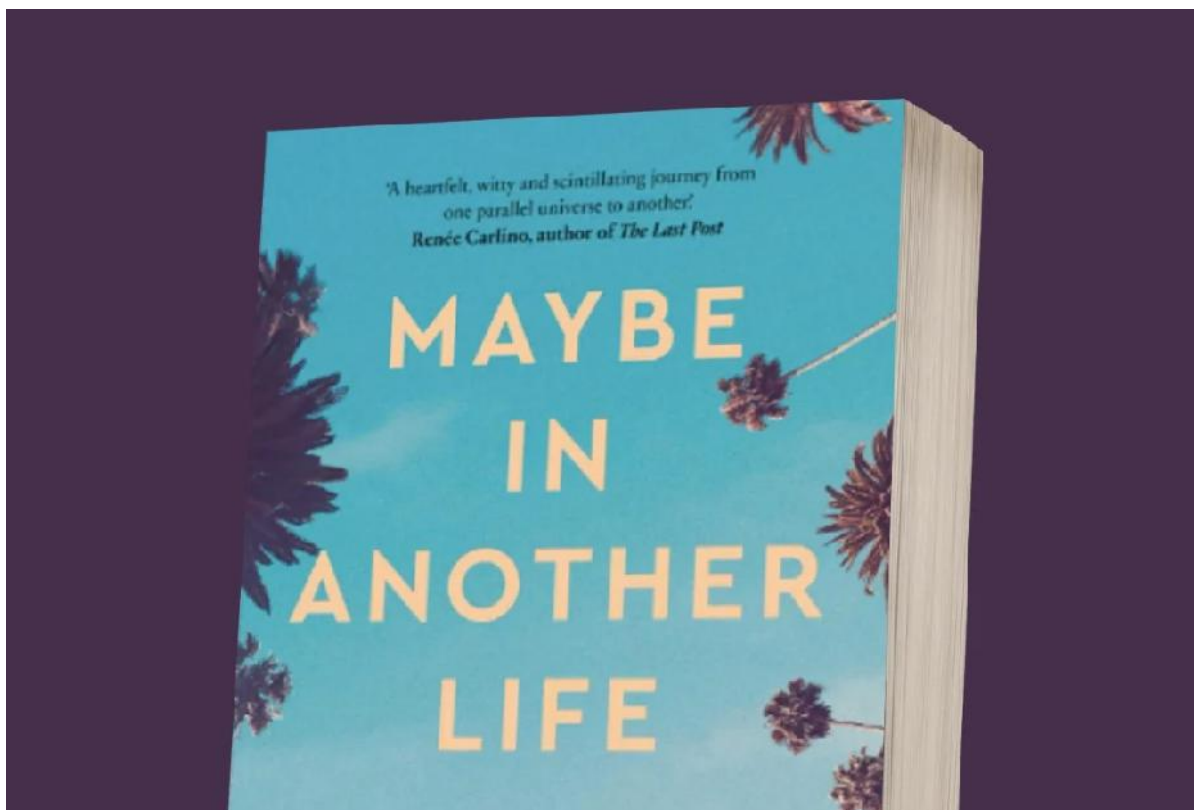

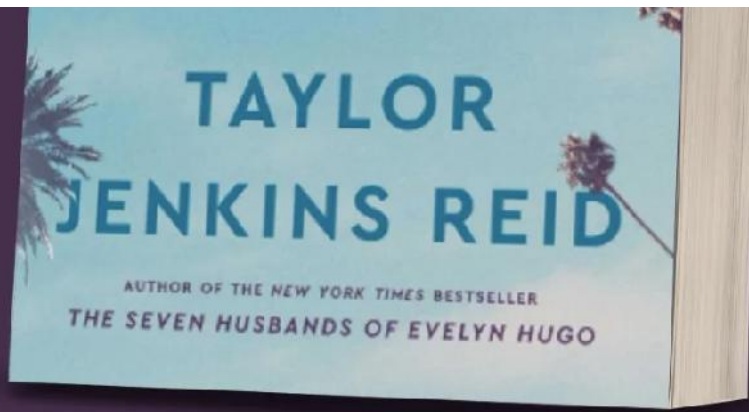

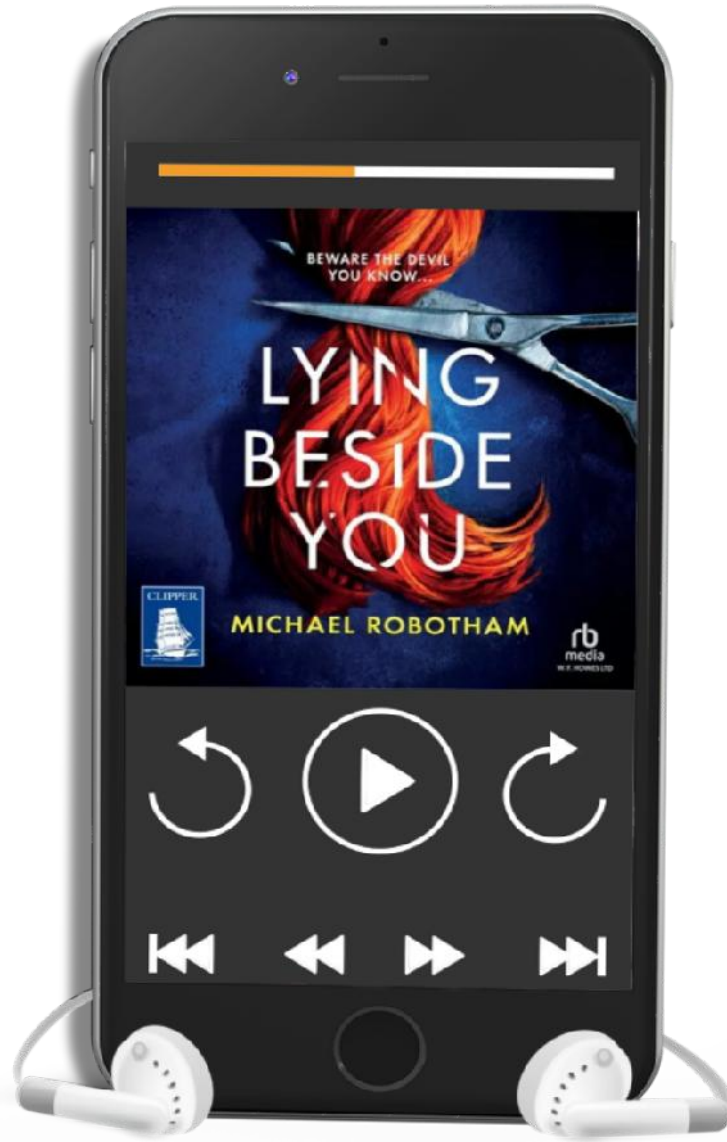

Books, films and music

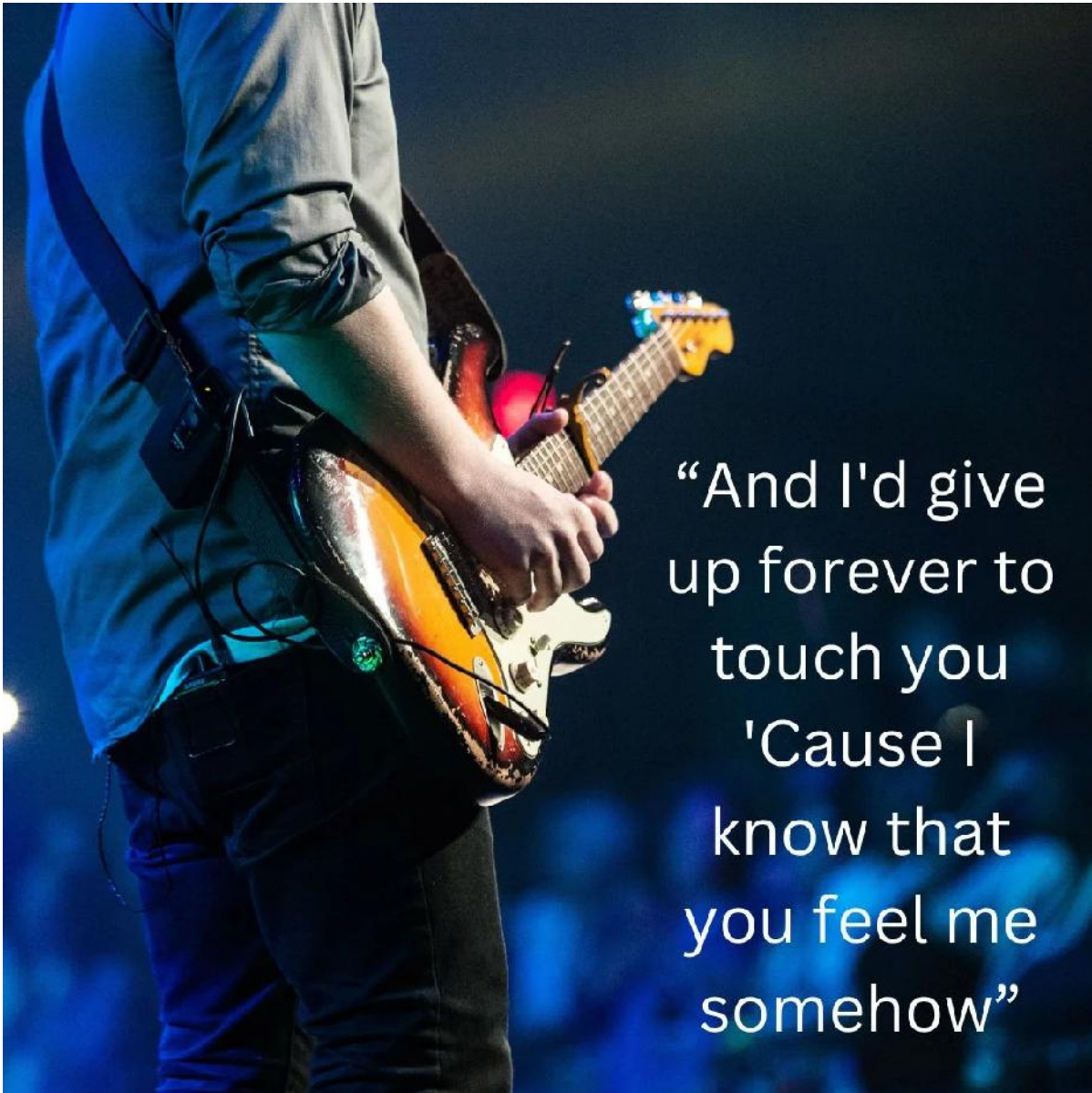

The third book in the series, I got to enjoy 11 hours of two of my favourite book characters: forensic psychologist Cyrus Haven, and the troubled but brilliant Evie Cormac, a young woman who has the uncanny ability to tell when people are lying. If you like a good crime fiction read, I highly recommend this series.
