


Although I'm generous with my time estimates, and I set realistic pre order dates, there's always this lurking fear that something is going to go wrong and an avalanche of problems will rain down on my head and get in the way of publication.

But here we are! *The Twelve Days Of Christian* will be out on November 12th. The print book has just gone live, which is super exciting. If you see it on Amazon, please ignore the crazy price! This strategy of launching it early at an inflated price serves two purposes.

First, it buys me time to get hold of an author copy and do one last check with the book in my hands. Although it has been read through over and over, including printed out on paper, it's never the same as reading the actual book. I'm hoping the typo gremlins haven't wormed their way into it anywhere, but this way I can be sure.

The second reason is it allows my lovely ARC readers to start posting reviews ahead of the official launch date. This really helps with preorders and early sales. I'm so grateful to this amazing group who gives up their time to read and give feedback.

Writers talk about their characters talking to them, and crazy as it may seem, it's true. Geordie and Jenna in *Blindsided By You* are back in business, disturbing my sleep. I recently reread everything I've written so far on this book and really loved it. So, every morning they're the first people I greet when I get up. I'm tentatively working towards an April release for this one.

Meanwhile, Rachel and Teddy from *Not My Little Drummer Boy*, the second book in the Stellar Riot Christmas series, have also started to nag at me. I'm not giving in to writing too much of their story just yet, but their characters and some important aspects of the plot are developing steadily.

I feel incredibly grateful that, although I should have started writing years ago, I get to do this thing I love, and it's so much fun sharing it with you.

Set in Australia, his descriptions of the settings make you feel you're right there. This is the seventh of his I've read and I highly recommend the audiobooks.



Watching: I've just blasted through all four seasons of *Emily In Paris*. How have I not watched this before? Sex And The City creator Darren Star brings another story of a young woman making her way in an iconic city, with friends, work, life and love. Then there's the clothes! I loved this one a lot and I'm so pleased there will be a fifth season.


What if parallel lives, the metaverse, and travel across time might really exist?
