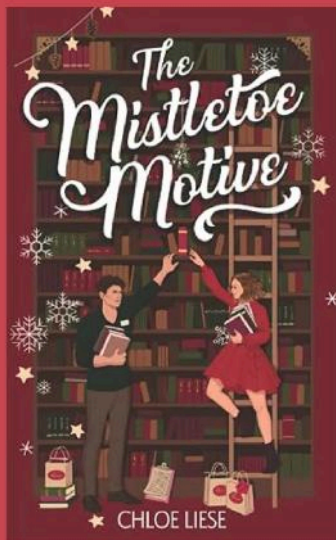

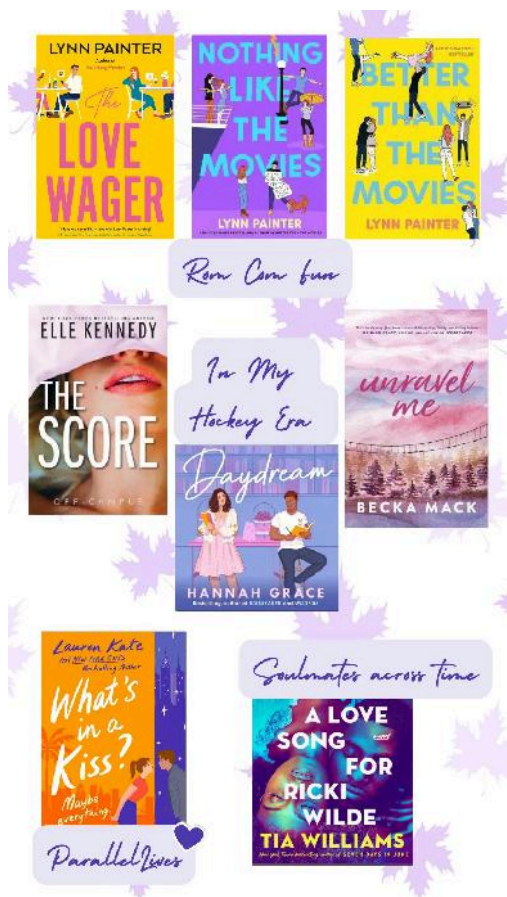

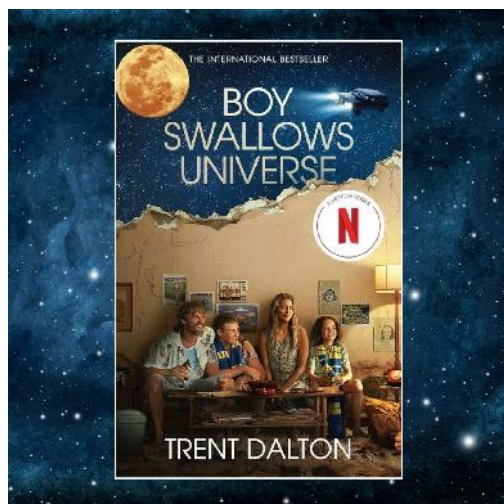
Books, films and music



Reading: I managed to fit in more books than I'd hoped this month in the midst of a book launch. Lynn Painter's books came highly recommended. I started with **The Love Wager**, and then wanting more of her snappy banter went straight into her two YA books, **Better Than The Movies** and **Nothing Like The Movies**. All three were so much fun. I've been enjoying more hockey romance, finishing Hannah Grace's Maple Hills series with the audiobook of **Daydream**, and a sweet, gentle couple. **Unravel Me** also featured a sweet FMC and a cinnamon roll hockey goalie. By contrast the MMC in **The Score** was a guy you probably shouldn't like but do.

What's In A Kiss by Lauren Kate was a buddy read and I loved it. With its parallel lives plot so like my **Tangled In Time** series, and including one of my favourite tropes—celebrity/normal person—it was my sort of book.

Lastly, my favourite book of the month, **A Love Song For Ricki Wilde**, also has magical realism at its heart. It's an enchanting story set in Harlem across two timelines. It's impossible to sum up the beauty of the story and the incredible characters in a few lines. It was recommended by my editor, Jackie, and she was spot on. I adored this book and highly recommend it.



Watching: It's been an all-Australian month for favourite watching. If you haven't seen **Boy Swallows Universe** (based on the book by Trent Dalton), go watch this incredible story. And if you're a **Yellowstone** fan feeling a gap in your viewing while you wait for more, check out **Territory**, a family saga set on a vast Northern Territory cattle ranch. It has all the drama, coupled with the harsh beauty of an unforgiving place.

Listening: As I write this, down the road from me, **Coldplay** are performing tonight. I'm home, living on the memory of last time they were here.

I've often used their music as inspiration when I write—the lyrics from 'The Scientist' belong to Will in **Tangled Hearts**, and 'Fix You' is Simon's song in **Tangled Past**. 'Feels Like I'm Falling In Love' made it to the playlist for **The Twelve Days of Christian**.
