



Chelsea Curto's Power Play was Book 2 in her DC Stars series. I loved it so much I bought Slap Shot and Hat Trick. I was a bit sad to finish Mr Swoony and Mr Charming this month because now there are no more in Piper Rayne's The Nest series. Although I did preorder

their Christmas novella where I'll get to see all four couples again. I've loved Julie Soto's books and I enjoyed her first step into romantasy with Rose In Chains. I especially liked the magic system in this one, as well as being captivated by our FMC Briony and the morally grey Toven Hearst. I also spent time with two of my other favourite morally grey characters, Victor Vale and Eli Ever, created by the incredible V.E.Schwab. Vengeful is a stunning sequel to Vicious and I can't believe it took me so long to get to it. I highly recommend Victoria's books and I love her newsletter too. Finally, I listened to Gillian McAllister's thriller, Famous Last Words, on audiobook. What if the police came to tell you your husband was involved in a hostage situation—and he was the hostage taker? I loved the premise of this book, extra good because the FMC was a literary agent and her husband a writer. This twisty tale also had a satisfying ending.

Watching: After a long wait, the first episodes of the Outlander prequel, Blood Of My Blood finally dropped on the weekend. If you're an Outlander fan you absolutely must watch, and even if you've never seen the main series or read the books, I think the intersection of two couples from two different times makes for a great story. I was also pleased to see the return of Wednesday. Spending time with the Addams family is so nostalgic. Another good watch was British series The Assassin, about an ex-assassin dragged unwillingly back into her old career to protect her son.
