Listening: I won some tickets to see **Counting Crows** in March (lucky me!), so it's been an excuse to trawl through their back catalogue in anticipation of the concert.

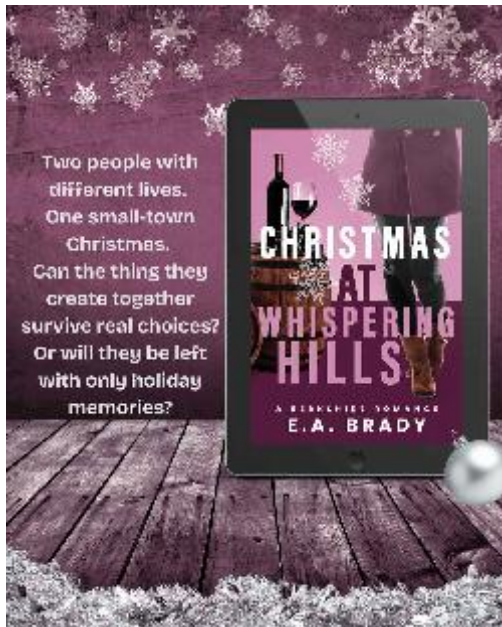
Author Update
