As the boundaries between her realities blur, Kate has to untangle the life she has from the life she might have had. If she can't, she risks losing both men—and herself—in the space between.

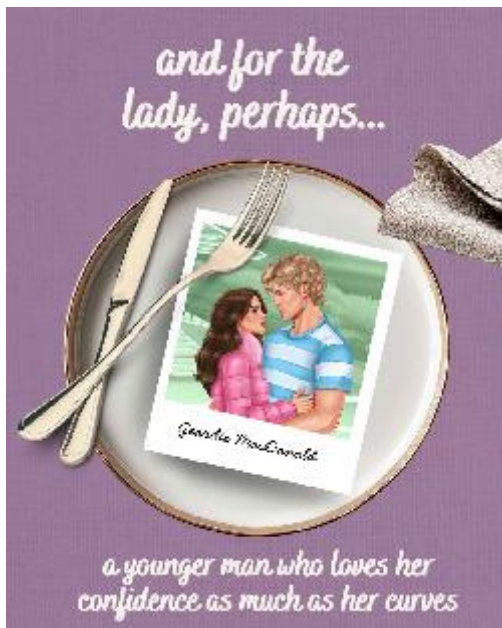
